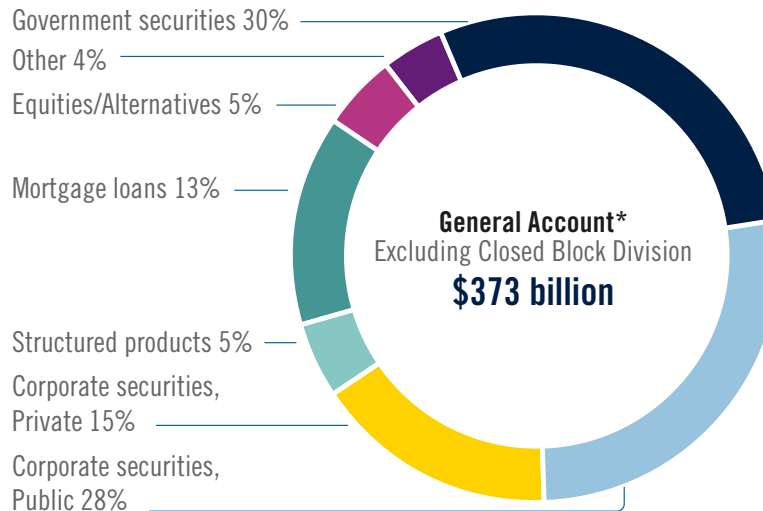

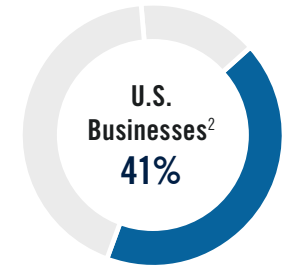

Twelve-month average



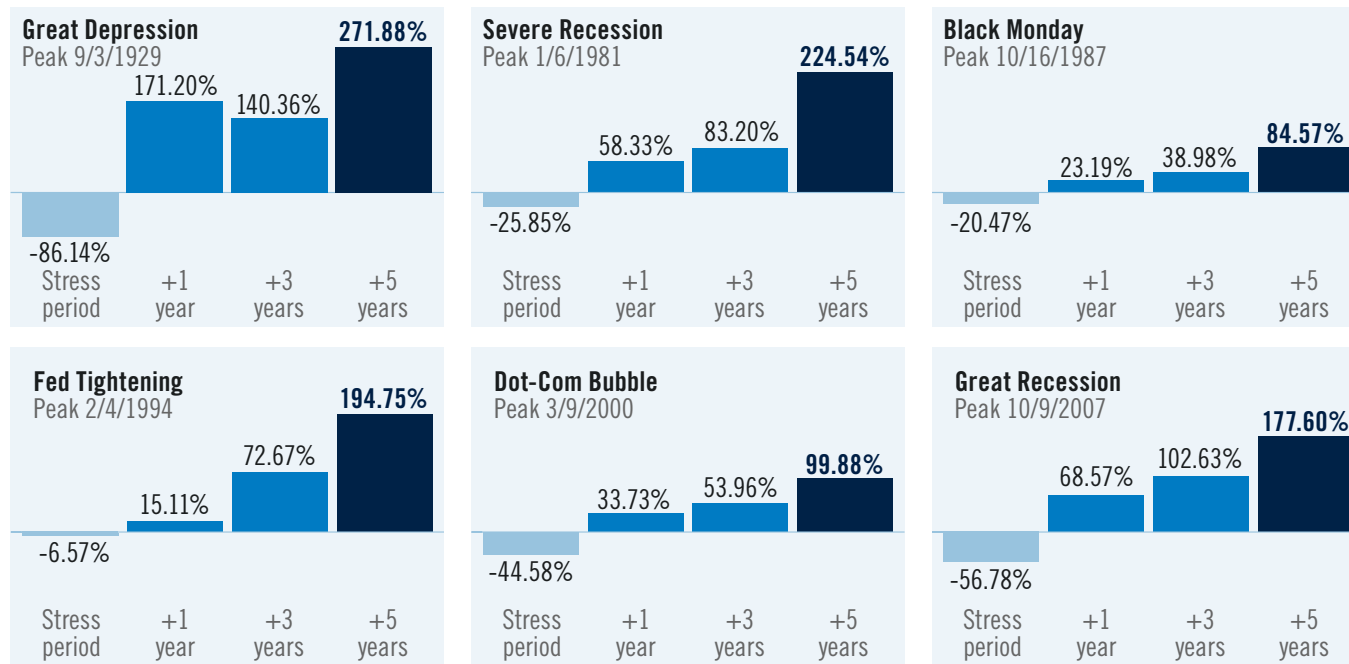

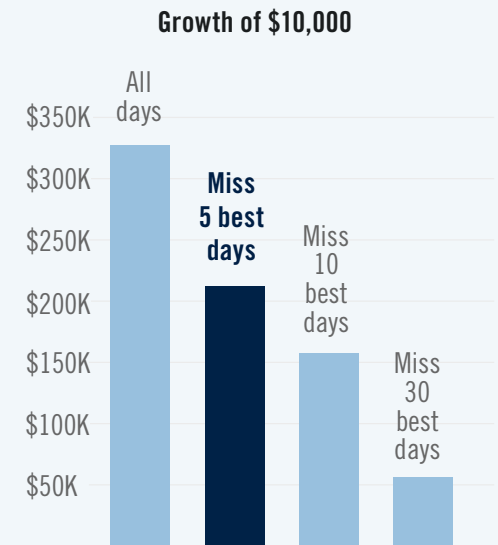
Market recovery after peak impact, shown as % change on S&P 500® Index

Hypothetical growth of \$10,000 in the S&P 500® from Jan. 4, 1988, to March 7, 2023



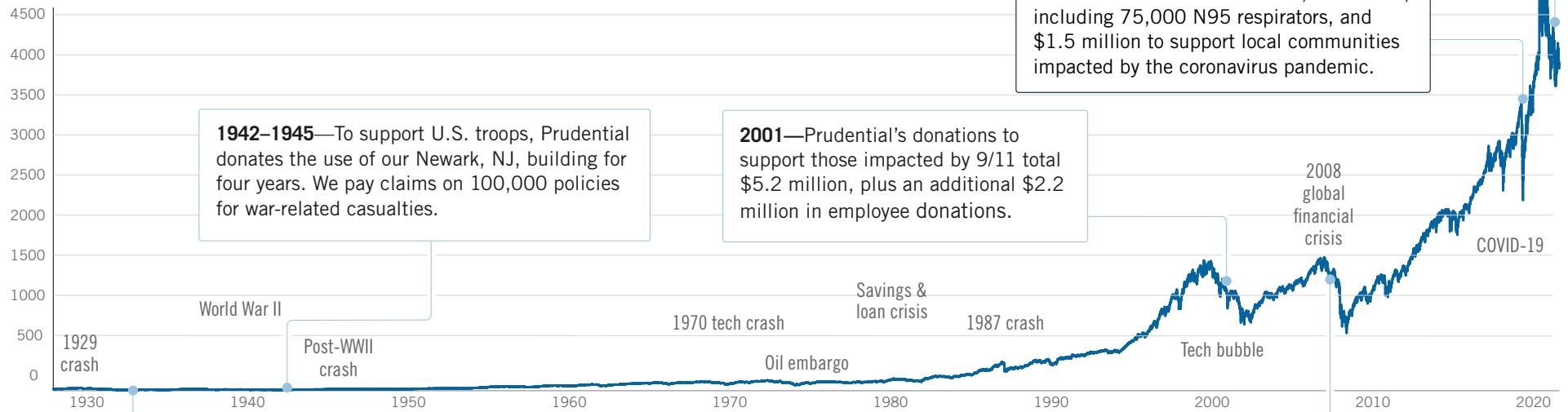

1942–1945—To support U.S. troops, Prudential donates the use of our Newark, NJ, building for four years. We pay claims on 100,000 policies for war-related casualties.

1932—We withstand the ravages of the Great Depression. Not one of our employees loses their job because of the economic conditions.

2008–2009—During the financial crisis, not only do we not access TARP money, but our investment group PGIM continues to support mid-size businesses by issuing \$15 billion in loans.

The Comdex gives the company's standing, on a scale of 1 to 100, in relation to other companies that have been rated by the services. It is an objective value based solely on the mathematical distribution of all of the companies that have been rated and is based on the ratings issued by the following rating services: A.M. Best, Standard & Poor's, Moody's Investors Service, and Fitch. An insurance company must have ratings from at least two of the major rating agencies to receive a Comdex ranking. 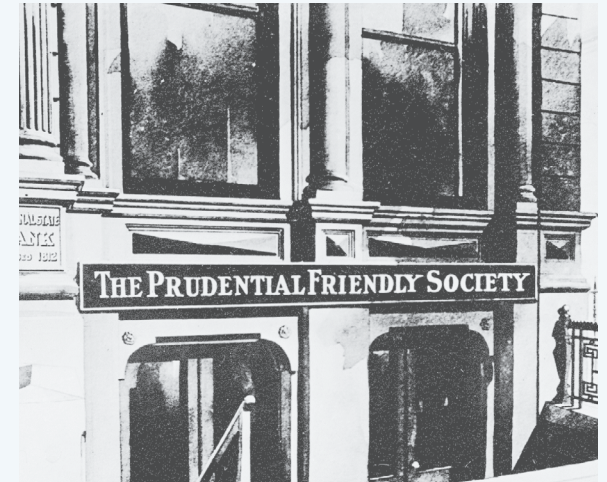
