Consumers make choices every day on how to save money. We want to remind you that you have the power to choose and save money by selecting a hospital that participates in the Hospital Choice Savings program.

When you require an inpatient stay and select a hospital that participates in the Hospital Choice Savings program, you'll receive a premium credit when you pay your Medicare supplement insurance premium as usual on the next renewal date. These hospitals work with Mutual of Omaha and its affiliates to keep costs down, which helps keep premium rate increases down in the future.

You're eligible for this credit when:

- You're hospitalized in a network hospital
- Your stay is classified as inpatient
- You haven't been hospitalized in the last 60 days

Frequently Asked Questions about the Hospital Choice Savings Program

Q: When I stay at a hospital in the Hospital Choice Savings program, how do I let them know I'm in a participating plan?

A: On the back of your insurance card is the USA Senior Care logo. When you show your insurance identification card at check-in, the facility will know you are a participating plan policyholder.

Q: How do I receive my \$100 credit?

A: Once you've paid your insurance premium on the next renewal date, your credit will be issued via check or ACH payment.

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
